Good News

Last Sunday, the group that I am part of, began studying the Natural Evangelism course; a six-week course that will help us to communicate with confidence the Good News about Jesus Christ. In session 1 we explored:

- What holds us back from sharing our faith with others?
- How people have reacted when we have tried to share our faith.
- Why Christianity is Good News.
- How we can be more creative in the way we share our faith.
- How evangelism involves both telling people about the Good News of Jesus and showing them the Good News - using words and works.

At the end of Jesus' life, he gave this charge to his followers:

'All authority in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Therefore go and make disciples of all nations ...' Matthew 28:18-19

If we are to take up this charge we need to be confident in speaking about our faith. Our hope is that everyone at St John's will complete this course by April 2017 and as a result be better equipped to talk about our faith. Please let me know if you would like to be part of the next group to begin this course.
