"What is Trinity Sunday?"

On Trinity Sunday, the Christian Church ponders with joy and thanksgiving what the Father, Son and Holy Spirit have done for us. We take time to reflect on how we should respond to the love God has shown us, praising Him and giving Him glory. We remember the Father as our creator, the Son as our saviour and the Holy Spirit as our comforter and guide. Although the word "trinity" does not appear in Scripture, it is clearly taught in Matthew 28:18-20 and 2 Corinthians 13:14 (and many other biblical passages).

Today, on Trinity Sunday we try to explain, to the best of man's ability, the clues written in Scripture to guide us to a fuller understanding of who God is. The Father is God from the beginning (John 1:1); Jesus revealed Himself as equal to the Father in John 10:30, "I and the Father are one." Together, they sent the Holy Spirit (John 14:26).

May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit be with you all. Steve
